## Structure of a Research Article

- Abstract
- Introduction
- Methods
- Results
- Discussion/Conclusion

## Why write a conclusion?

- Provides an overview/summary of your main ideas
- Moves the reader from the specific details contained in your paper to the general ideas you want to leave them with
- Allows you to be provocative and let the reader consider ideas beyond your existing work

## A good conclusion should...

- provide an overview of the main ideas in a concise, cohesive way.
- synthesize, not summarize.
- leave the reader with a holistic perspective of your work.
- answer the questions, "So what?" or "Why should I care?"
- discuss ideas for future research
